



T-2 Program Options in 2010

The week-long high adventure program, T-2, is designed for Scouts 14 years of age and older, who have participated in the traditional Boy Scout summer camp program and are now searching for the next challenge. We are expanding the T-2 program offerings again to include three different programs to choose from. Scouts can either register for the "In Camp Experience", "Out of Camp Adventure", or the new pilot program the "Advanced Skills Expedition" (climbing, sailing, & kayaking focused). All programs offer high adventure experiences during the day and time for Scouts to spend with their troop during select evenings.

T-2 "In Camp Experience"

Program Details

- Scouts participate in different programs each day. The program takes place primarily within the borders of Tomahawk and allows Scouts to experience the extreme elements of the camp.
- Programs include climbing the new 60' mega climbing tower, mountain biking, action archery, skeet shooting, climbing the inflatable iceberg, Scouts vs. staff competitions, high ropes on the 50' COPE course, and a circumnavigation around the Tomahawk peninsula.
- Program fee \$255

T-2 "Out of Camp Adventure"

Program Details

- Scouts participate in different programs each day. Some programs take place off camp property so Scouts can experience outdoor elements not found within Tomahawk.
- Programs consist of a variety of day long experiences including rock climbing at Taylor's Falls, mountain biking on backcountry trails, whitewater kayaking on the Brule River, low and high COPE on the 50' COPE course, an overnight outpost, and more.
- Program fee \$290

T-2 "Advanced Skills Expedition" – *New Pilot Program for 2010*

The focus is on climbing, sailing, & kayaking)

Program Details

- Rather than being themed around a wide variety of activities this program is designed older Scouts interested in learning advanced skills focused around climbing, sailing, and kayaking.
- Programs consist of time spent on advanced development of climbing skills by participating in climbing instructional trainings, climbing on the Tomahawk Mega tower, and natural rock climbing on the North Shore. Advanced sailing and kayaking skills are taught on Long Lake at Tomahawk using excellent equipment, trained staff, and significant time for skill development. Program offerings may also include use of rowing sculls, 22' Chrysler sailboats, and catamarans depending on time available to participate in these activities.
- Program fee \$230 (one-time reduced fee offered in 2010 as a pilot program)

The T-2 fees take the place of the fee for camp. Fees include all rental of special equipment for in and out of camp day trips, staff support, transportation, and food. You can't beat this price or the experience.

Space is limited; see the "2010 T-2 Registration Process" document to learn the specific steps to making a reservation. Reservations received prior to March 12 will not get priority and will be all processed on March 12th according to the registration process.
