



2012 T-2 Registration Process

The following is a comprehensive outline of the registration process:

- 1) Scouts must be a minimum of 14 years old at the time of the program dates to register for any of the T-2 programs.
- 2) Reservations will be accepted starting on Thursday March 15, 2012. If on March 15 we have received more reservations than the capacity for the program for a specific week, priority will be given to Scouts based on age then rank. *(Example: If there are 24 spaces available for a program during week 1 and we receive 26 reservations the oldest 24 Scouts with the highest rank will be selected to participate in the program. If we have received more reservations than we have space available on March 15 and if several Scouts are the same age and rank a random selection will take place to determine participants.)* **After March 15 all reservations will strictly be taken on a first come first serve basis.**
- 3) Unit leaders may submit the completed T-2 registration form via mail, fax, or email. Mail to 393 Marshall Ave St. Paul, MN 55102, fax 763-231-7202, email kburbank@nsbsa.org. A \$50 non-refundable and non-transferable deposit per participant **must be received within 10 days** or your reservation will be canceled.
- 4) Deposits count toward the overall T-2 camp fee. If the program is full on the date you have selected your troop will receive a credit for deposits paid which will be applied to your Tomahawk summer camp fees.
- 5) A confirmation will be sent within 10 business days to the unit leader who made the reservation indicating acceptance or denial based on capacity of the reservation.
- 6) The remainder of the T-2 camp fee will be assessed with the troop invoice at the conclusion of your week at Tomahawk.

Note 1: Reservations received prior to March 15 will not get priority and will be all processed on March 15th according to the registration process

Note 2: Since engaging in these activities as a group is key, we do reserve the right to cancel if we do not meet minimum capacity requirements. The program will need at least 4 participants to sustain the program for any week. In the event of a cancellation a refund will be granted to the troop or applied to the troop's remaining fee balance. It is rare that we have to cancel a program.
